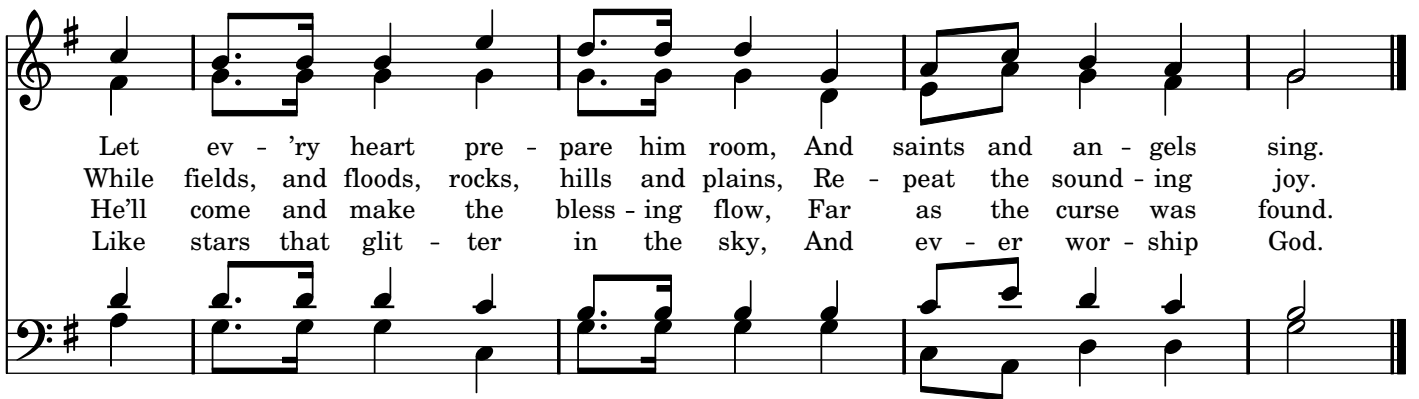


# Joy to the World
